Why I can only see parts of the Dashboard?

This Dashboard is best viewed on a desktop computer.

When you browse the Dashboard on a smartphone or a tablet, you can simply pinch open on the screen to zoom in and pinch close to zoom out everything.

When you browse the Dashboard on a desktop computer, a modern web browser will allow you to hold down the Ctrl key (Command key on a Macintosh) and press the + or - key to zoom in or zoom out.
